AMENDED NOTICE OF MOTION

TO: (I) THE OFFICE OF THE UNITED STATES TRUSTEE FOR THE DISTRICT OF DELAWARE, (II) COUNSEL TO THE OFFICIAL COMMITTEE OF UNSECURED CREDITORS APPOINTED IN THIS CASE, (III) COUNSEL TO WELLS FARGO RETAIL FINANCE, LLC; (IV) THE KNOWN PARTIES HAVING AN INTEREST IN THE LEASES; AND (V) ALL THOSE HAVING FILED REQUESTS FOR NOTICE PURSUANT TO BANKRUPTCY RULE 2002.

On September 26, 2002, the above-captioned debtor and debtor in possession (the "Debtor") filed and served the **MOTION FOR ORDER: (A) SETTING (1) DATE TO CONDUCT AUCTION OF DEBTOR'S INTERESTS IN REAL PROPERTY LEASES, AND (2) HEARING DATE FOR APPROVAL OF AUCTION; (B) APPROVING BIDDING PROCEDURES AND TERMS OF AUCTION INCLUDING PAYMENT OF BREAK-UP FEE; (C) ESTABLISHING CURE AMOUNTS; (D) AUTHORIZING DEBTOR TO ENTER INTO LEASE TERMINATION AGREEMENTS; (E) APPROVING ABANDONMENT OF PERSONAL PROPERTY; (F) APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING SALE OF LEASES TO HIGHEST OR BEST BIDDER FREE AND CLEAR OF ALL LIENS, INTERESTS, CLAIMS AND ENCUMBRANCES PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 363(b), 363(d) AND 363(m) OF THE BANKRUPTCY CODE; (G) APPROVING PROCEDURES FOR THE REJECTION OF CERTAIN LEASES; (H) WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF FEDERAL RULES OF BANKRUPTCY PROCEDURE 6004(g) AND 6006(d); AND (I) GRANTING RELATED RELIEF** (the "Motion"). You were previously served with the Motion.

A HEARING HAS BEEN SCHEDULED FOR OCTOBER 10, 2002 AT 12:00 P.M. (ET) BEFORE THE HONORABLE PETER J. WALSH, IN THE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF DELAWARE, 824 MARKET STREET, 6TH FLOOR, WILMINGTON, DELAWARE 19801 (THE "BID PROCEDURES HEARING") TO CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE PROPOSED BID PROCEDURES (AS DEFINED IN THE MOTION).

Parties wishing to object to the Bid Procedures must file an objection on or before October 3, 2002 at 4:00 p.m. (ET) (the "Bidding Procedures Objection Deadline") with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, 824 Market Street, 5th Floor, Wilmington, Delaware 19801.

At the same time, you must also serve a copy of the objection upon the undersigned counsel to the Debtor so that the objection is received on or before the Bid Procedures Objection Deadline.

A HEARING TO CONSIDER APPROVAL OF THE SALE OF THE LEASES (AS DEFINED IN THE MOTION) AND THE REMAINDER OF THE RELIEF REQUESTED IN THE MOTION WILL BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 22, 2002 AT 3:30 P.M. (ET), BEFORE THE HONORABLE PETER J. WALSH IN THE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF DELAWARE, 824 MARKET STREET, 6TH FLOOR, WILMINGTON, DELAWARE 19801 (THE "SALE HEARING").

Parties wishing to object to the sale of the Leases (as defined in the Motion) and the remainder of the relief requested in the Motion must do so by filing an objection on or before November 15, 2002 at 4:00 p.m. (ET) (the "Objection Deadline") with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware, 824 Market Street, 5th Floor, Wilmington, Delaware 19801.


At the same time, you must also serve a copy of the objection upon the undersigned counsel to the Debtor so that the objection is received on or before the Objection Deadline.

WALSH, IN THE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF DELAWARE, 824 MARKET STREET, 6TH FLOOR, WILMINGTON, DELAWARE 19801.
