**OMNIBUS ORDER APPROVING QUARTERLY APPLICATIONS OF COMMITTEE PROFESSIONALS FOR COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES**

Upon consideration of the quarterly fee applications (the "Applications")<sup>1</sup> of those professionals (the "Professionals") referenced on Exhibit A attached hereto, pursuant to sections 105(a) and 331 of title 11 of the United States Code, Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2016 and that certain *Order Establishing Procedures for Interim Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Professionals and Members of Official Committee* (the "Administrative Order") previously entered by this Court on May 20, 2010; and it appearing that the Court has jurisdiction to consider the Applications and the relief requested therein in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1134; and it appearing that this matter is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and it appearing that venue of this proceeding and these Applications is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and due and proper notice of the Applications having been given; and an objection having been filed by NexBank, SSB (Docket No. 383) (the "NexBank Objection"); and it appearing that the relief requested in the Applications is in the best interests of the Debtors and their estates and creditors; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor;

It is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED, and DECREED that:

1. The Applications are granted on an interim basis in the amounts (the "Allowed Compensation Amounts") set forth on Exhibit A hereto for services rendered and reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred during the fee periods set forth on Exhibit A.
2. The Debtors are authorized and directed to pay the Professionals the Allowed Compensation Amounts as set forth on Exhibit A hereto, less any amounts previously paid to the Professionals by the Debtors for services rendered and reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred during the fee periods set forth on Exhibit A, as permitted by this Court's interim fee procedures order..
3. Entry of this Order is without prejudice to the rights and objections raised by NexBank, SSB ("NexBank"), with respect to the allowance or disallowance of any amounts sought in the Applications, including those objections raised in the NexBank Objection and/or the rights of the Professionals with respect to the Applications and the NexBank Objection, all of which rights and objections are expressly reserved.
4. The NexBank Objection and consideration of all amounts for services rendered and reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred during the fee periods set forth in the Applications other than the Allowed Compensation Amount approved on an interim basis by this Order shall be continued to a date and time to be established by the Professionals upon further notice.
5. All future compensation payments to the Professionals shall be subject to order of the Court.

6. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from or relating to this Order, including, but not limited to the contested amounts set forth on Exhibit A hereto.


