

**SECOND MONTHLY APPLICATION OF SHUMAKER, LOOP & KENDRICK, LLP
FOR COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND REIMBURSEMENT OF
EXPENSES AS SPECIAL COUNSEL TO THE DEBTORS FOR THE PERIOD
FROM SEPTEMBER 1, 2010 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 2010**

Shumaker, Loop & Kendrick, LLP (“Shumaker” or “Applicant”), special counsel to Moll Industries, Inc. and its affiliated Debtors (the “Debtors”), hereby submits its application, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330, 331 and 503(b)(4), Rule 2016 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and Del. Bankr. L.R. 2016-2, for interim allowance of compensation for services rendered and for reimbursement of expenses incurred solely for the Debtors, and in further explanation respectfully represents:

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this application, Shumaker seeks, with regard to the Debtors, (i) an interim allowance and award of compensation for professional services rendered by Shumaker, as special counsel for the Debtors, for the period from September 1, 2010 through and including November 30, 2010 (the “Compensation Period”) in the amount of \$1,063.00 representing 3.00 hours in professional services incurred by Shumaker during the Compensation Period (the “Application”).

2. This Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334. This is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2). Venue of this proceeding and this application is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§1408 and 1409. The statutory predicates for the relief sought herein are 11 U.S.C. §§ 330, 331, 503(b)(4), Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2016 and Del. Bankr. L.R. 2016-2.

II. BACKGROUND

3. On April 27, 2010 (the “Petition Date”), the Debtors each filed with this Court a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code (the “Bankruptcy Code”). Pursuant to sections 1107 and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code, the Debtors are continuing to operate their businesses and manage their properties as debtors-in-possession. The Office of the United States Trustee appointed the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors on May 10, 2010.

4. After the Petition Date, the Debtors retained Shumaker as special employment and labor counsel to represent them in these proceedings. This Court approved the retention of Shumaker as counsel to the Debtors *nunc pro tunc* to July 28, 2010 (the “Retention Date”) by order dated August 23, 2010 (Docket No. 289).

5. Applicant has received no payments or promises of payment from any source other than the Debtors for services rendered or to be rendered in any capacity whatsoever in these cases. There is no agreement or understanding between Shumaker and any other person for the sharing of compensation in connection with this case, other than in accordance with the provisions of the Bankruptcy Code.

6. The services for which compensation is being sought by Shumaker were rendered for and on behalf of the Debtors and not for or on the behalf of any other interested party in this bankruptcy proceeding.

III. TIME RECORDS AND HOURLY RATES

7. Frederick M. Thurman, Jr. and David A. Matthews of Shumaker provided services for the Debtors during the Compensation Period. Mr. Thurman was admitted to the Bar of the Supreme Court of Alabama in 1995 and the North Carolina State Bar in 1999. Mr. Thurman became an associate with Shumaker in November 1998 and became a partner at Shumaker effective January 1, 2003. Applicant charged \$345.00 per hour for services rendered by Mr. Thurman during the Compensation Period.

8. Mr. Matthews was admitted to the Bar of the Supreme Court of California in 1998 and the State of North Carolina in 2002. Mr. Matthews became an associate with Shumaker in September 2001 and became a partner at Shumaker effective January 1, 2010. Applicant charged \$415.00 per hour for services rendered by Mr. Matthews during the period covered by this Application.

9. The total time spent by Shumaker representing the Debtors during the Compensation Period was 3.00 hours and the compensation sought for the Compensation Period is \$1,063.00. This equates to a blended rate of \$354.50 per hour.

10. Attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference, are Shumaker's time records showing a daily log of all time spent by Shumaker providing services for the Debtors during the Compensation Period by Project Category. The attached time records provide a detailed, day-by-day explanation of the services rendered by Shumaker in connection

with this matter during that time. Applicant certifies that Applicant has reviewed Del. Bankr. L.R. 2016-2 and believes that the Application complies therewith.

IV. GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES RENDERED

11. The services rendered by Shumaker that are the subject of this Application include (i) reviewing and revising their fee application; and (ii) advising and representing the Debtors with respect to plant closing issues, employee layoffs and WARN Act notices.

V. CONCLUSION

12. The compensation sought by Applicant is based on the normal hourly rates charged by Applicant for work of this character. The services rendered by Applicant to the Debtors were necessary and appropriate and to date have benefited the Debtors, their creditors, and estates. The amount of compensation sought by Shumaker is consistent with the factors enumerated in 11 U.S.C. §330, in that the amount sought is reasonable compensation for actual, necessary services rendered by the Applicant taking into account all relevant factors, including time spent on such services; the rates charged for such services; the complexity, importance, and nature of the problem, issue or task addressed; and the customary compensation charged by comparably skilled practitioners in cases other than cases under the Bankruptcy Code.


WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this Court enter an order:
