**ORDER PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 1452 AND BANKRUPTCY  
RULES 9006(b) AND 9027 FURTHER EXTENDING THE DEBTORS' TIME TO  
FILE NOTICES OF REMOVAL OF CLAIMS AND CAUSES OF ACTION  
RELATED TO THE DEBTORS' CHAPTER 11 CASES**

Upon the Debtors' Second Motion,<sup>2</sup> Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1452 and Bankruptcy Rules 9006(b) and 9027 for Entry of an Order Further Extending the Debtors' Time to File Notices of Removal of Claims and Causes of Action Related to the Debtors' Chapter 11 Cases; and it appearing that this Court has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157(b) and 1334; and it appearing that this is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); and that venue of this proceeding and the Motion is proper in this district pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; and due and proper notice of the Motion having been given; and after due deliberation and it appearing that sufficient cause exists for granting the requested relief and that the relief requested is in the best interest of the Debtors, their estates, and their creditors;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. The Motion is granted.



2. The time period provided by Bankruptcy Rule 9027 within which the Debtors may file notices of removal of related proceedings under Bankruptcy Rule 9027(a)(2) and (a)(3) is enlarged and extended through and including January 24, 2011;

3. The January 24, 2011 deadline to file removal actions applies to all matters specified in Bankruptcy Rule 9027; and

4. This Order is without prejudice to the Debtors' rights to seek further extensions of the time within which to remove related proceedings.
